VitaMSO can vary in color from Yellow to Light Amber depending on the oil stock.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE Use VitaMSO at a rate of 1-3 pts/acre with pesticides that suggest or require COC or MSO. Use higher rate if weed pressure is high or the weeds are under stress. Always follow the label of the specific herbicide for detailed adjuvant directions.

MIXING & HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS SHAKE WELL before using. Add VitaMSO late in your tank mix and continue agitation. It is recommended to wear safety goggles, splash apron, and rubber gloves when handling this and all other chemicals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Store product in original container. Do not store near open flame. Do not re-use container. Do not contaminate food, water, or animal feed. Keep packaging closed, securely fastened and upright. Product may be suspended in layers if stored below 45 degrees. Triple rinse prior to disposal.
